As professionals, we create engaging multimedia that tells the story of historical hidden gems in our city.

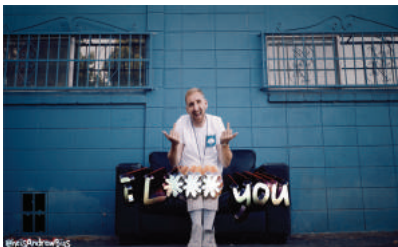
